WHAT TO EXPECT

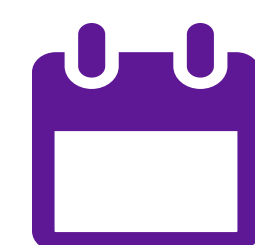
- Testimony by those who live with addiction, family members and those who have lost a loved one from this disease will be on hand to share their experience strength and hope
